Detailed Narrative:

The purpose of today's visit to this workplace by the Ministry of Labour (MOL) was to gather information following a complaint about asbestos exposure.

The following items were discussed:

- An event involving rooms 6360, 6366, 6368, 7366 and 7368 was discussed. Workplace parties indicted that there were 4 communications sent out to occupants of the affected area.
- The workplace parties advised that comminication regarding asbestos events is drafted by the EHS and sent to the administrative management of the departments involved for distribution.
- Meetings with departments have been held to discuss the event.
- The JHSC for the MSB has been notified of testing being conducted and results, as confirmed by the worker representative. Should other JHSC be associated with the building, the employer is advised that this committees should also be notified of testing being conducted and provided an opportunity to be present during the start of testing if they believe their presence is required to ensure valid testing procedures are used or to ensure that the test results are valid.
- The results are being posted on a bulletin board near the 2nd floor elevators of the MSB, which is accessible to all workers, Workplace parties advised that to date, there are 207 results. Results are also being posted on a portal. It is reported that results are being posted within 24 hours of receiving them.
- Ongoing air sampling is being undertaken. It should be noted that this environmental air sampling is not considered "clearance air sampling" and the requirements for clearance air sampling under O. Reg 278/05 do not apply.

- Workplace parties confirmed that Type 3 abatement activities are not being conducted at this time.
- The timeline of the cleaning and sampling of the 6th floor work space was discussed. The JHSC worker rep advised that he was notified of the air sampling being conducted.
- The JHSC worker rep was not aware of any formal work refusal being conducted. The worker rep was not involved in conducting a Stage 1 for a work refusal.
- Communications of the event have been distributed to the JHSC/Union for the cleaners and cafeteria workers in the building.
