To begin they will collect air samples from the sixth floor of MSB starting Friday March 10 at 9:30am and continue on remaining floors Monday onwards until the building has been completed.. These sampling sessions take approx. 75 min.We're working with the university's leadership – operations and research, including Environmental Health & Safety – to ensure test results, methodologies and context is made available to all who would like to review.

As soon as we have that information we will share this with you.
