EHS Respirator Fit-Testing Procedures during COVID-19

Last Updated: January 19, 2022

- 1. EHS follows all applicable hygiene practices such as frequent hand washing, use of hand sanitizer, and wearing of medical masks and disposable gloves. Tabletops and fit-test equipment will be wiped down with disinfecting wipes before the session and between each fit-test participant. Only the fit-tester and the employee/student being tested will be allowed in the room at one time. Fit-tester will wash hands before the session and will wear disposable nitrile gloves when handling any fit-test equipment and respirators. The fit-tester will advise the employee/student to sanitize their hands using the bottle of hand sanitizer provided.
- 2. Employee/students are advised to use their own pens when completing any documents. If the participant does not have a pen, the fit-tester will provide a pen to the participant after cleaning the pen with a disinfectant wipe.
- 3. Employee/student being fit-tested and EHS staff wear medical masks per UofT policy. The employee/student being fit-tested will sit at a designated seat located behind a plexiglass barrier and will keep their medical mask on until it is time to don the respirator.
- 4. The fit-tester will install the tubing to the probe (for N95 respirators) or attaching respirator cartridges with tubing connected (for half- or full-face masks) onto the respirator that the employee/student brings with them to the fit test. There will be no sharing of respirators employee/student are expected to bring their own respirator, particularly the elastomeric respirator. The tubing that extends from the respirator cartridges used during the fit test will be disinfected between users.
- 5. The employee/student will be given instructions on how to don the respirator. The instructions will be given verbally, from at least 2 metres away, and behind a plexiglass barrier.
- 6. The fit test itself will have 7 breathing exercises prompted by the software. The fittester will be 2 metres away to observe and provide instructions to the employee/student throughout the test.
- 7. After the fit-test is complete and with the employee/student still wearing the respirator, the fit-tester will demonstrate how to properly perform a positive and negative pressure seal check.
- 8. After the fit test, the employee/student will doff the respirator and pass the respirator back to the fit-tester through the opening at the bottom of the plexiglass. The fit-tester will remove the respirator cartridges and/or tubing. Employee/student will re-don their medical mask. The fit-tester will then demonstrate how to properly disinfect the respirator using a respirator cleaning wipe (for half- or full-face masks).
- 9. N95 respirators which have been used for the fit-test will be disposed. Respirator cartridges used during the fit-test will be disinfected with disinfectant wipes.
- 10. A fit testing card will be given to the staff/student after the fit test.
- 11. Reminders employee/students must be clean shaven, have taken the online training, and provide the respirator user screening form prior to the fit test.
