### Appendix 1.

Equivalent amounts (as per Schedule 3 of the Cannabis Act). Recreated from the Cannabis Licensing Application Guide – Research, September 6, 2019

Class of cannabis	Quantity that is equivalent to 1 g of dried cannabis
Dried cannabis	1 g
Fresh cannabis	5 g
Solids containing cannabis	15 g
Non-solid containing cannabis	70 g
Cannabis solid concentrates	0.25 g
Cannabis non-solid concentrates	0.25 g
Cannabis plant seeds	1 seed

Note: Non-dried cannabis in solid and non-solid forms are considered cannabis concentrates when above 3% THC by weight
