

First Aiders Guidance



Definitions:

First Aid: Immediate care given to a person who is injured or ill. Treatment is given until medical aid by a health care professional can be administered (if applicable).

First Aid Box: A box or container that must, at the minimum, contain items listed in: Sections 8, 9, 10, 11 or 16 of Regulation 1101; or, the CSA Standard, First Aid Kits for the Workplace Z1220-17

First Aider: A person holding a valid First Aid Certificate issued by a training agency recognized by the Workplace Safety & Insurance Board (WSIB).

First Aider Responsibilities:

- 1. To respond to first aid emergencies within the limits of their training.
- 2. To **obtain and maintain a valid First Aid Certificate** issued by a training agency recognized by the WSIB.
- 3. To follow appropriate emergency procedures and provide *interim first aid until medical services* takes over.
- 4. To be in charge of a first aid station and inspect the first aid box and its contents at least every three months (4X/year) and replenish the supplies if needed. The inspection card/checklist for the first aid box should be signed and dated. Refer to this link for a checklist: <u>https://ehs.utoronto.ca/training/first-aid-training/#checklist</u>
- 5. To *keep a record*, indicating the date, time, and nature of the first aid treatment given to any injured person.

Advise injured worker to complete a University of Toronto *accident / incident online eForm report* with their supervisor within 24 hours. Details and information on how to complete this form is located on the EHS website at: <u>https://ehs.utoronto.ca/report-an-incident/</u>.

First Aid Stations shall contain/post:

A <i>first aid box</i> * containing the items required by Reg. 1101 or CSA	an <i>inspection</i> card/checklist,
the WSIB Form 82 poster, ' <i>In Case of Injury at Work</i> '**, and	valid <i>first aid certificates</i> of the first aiders.

Other personal protective equipment (e.g., CPR barrier mask and non-latex gloves) as prescribed by the first aid training should also be included in the first aid box.
